Presenter: First Assistant Chief Charles Cato, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

First Assistant Chief Cato provided the committee with a progress report of the Police Department in crime.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: There were no recommendations for this item.

4. 2011 Crime Summary

Presenter: Deputy Chief Randall Blankenbaker, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

The purpose of the briefing is to provide a comprehensive 2011 annual crime report for the City of Dallas and give an overview of historical trending patterns. In conducting these types of analysis, this will assist the Department in identifying continuing steps in order to reach the following goals:

- Experience an unprecedented 9 years of overall crime reduction
- Make Dallas one of the 5 safest large cities by reducing the overall crime rate

2011 Crime Statistics are as follows:

- Unprecedented 8th consecutive year of total crime reduction, YTD -4.14%
- 10th consecutive year of violent crime reduction, YTD -8.76%
- 3rd lowest murder rate in modern era
- Lowest per capita murder rate in 54 years (1957)
- Lowest number of actual murders in 44 years (1967)
- Total crime down 38.9% since 2003

Contributing Factors to Crime Reduction are as follows:

- Innovative Crime Reduction Strategies
 - Staffing increases and strategies allocation of resources
 - Compstat
 - Hot Spot Policing
 - Operation Disruption
 - Summer Crime Initiatives
 - Fusion Center
 - Improved Technology
 - Bait Cars (UUMV and BMV)
 - Surveillance Cameras
 - Leveraging community and corporate resources
- Continued support by the Council to add address staffing needs and place a priority on public safety
- Leverage citizen participation in:
 - Volunteer programs
 - Crime Watch Groups
- Partnerships with non-profit organizations and foundations

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) crime reduction (2) change in definition of rape (3) rape cases (4) Bair car technology (5) burglary crimes (6) pamphlets on residential burglaries (7) hot spot policing (8) summer crime initiatives (9) Bait vehicle in entertainment district and (10) progress report on camera technology.

5. Dallas Police Homicide Report

Presenter: Lt. David Hughes, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

The purpose of the briefing is to provide a comprehensive 2011 annual homicide report for the City of Dallas and give an overview of historical trending patterns. The Dallas Police Department is striving to reduce Homicides in 2012. This reduction can be achieved through the following: (1) Intelligence based policing and deployment of personnel (2) Increased participation of investigators patrolling in high crime areas and (3) Rapid resolution of homicide offenses and arrest of offenders.

Annual Homicide Review is as follows:

- 2011 Homicide Review
 - The Dallas Police Department reported 133 Homicides for 2011
 - This is a 10% reduction from the 148 Homicides reported in 2010

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) investigators (2) clearance rate (3) economical factor (4) handguns (5) race of suspect (6) information on first offender's/adult program (7) type of premises (8) CTPED and (9) suicide cases.
