#### 2. Dallas Museum of Art Update

Dr. Anderson updated the committee on programs and membership at the Dallas Museum of Art. The museum will begin offering free membership and general admission beginning January 21, 2013. Additionally, the museum's education efforts in the community were highlighted.

Ms. Hill stated that she is not as optimistic as Dr. Anderson about the shift in visitor demographics as a result of free admission.

In response to Ms. Jasso's question about offsetting revenue lost by granting free general admission, Dr. Anderson explained that most ticketed revenue is from exhibitions. Additionally, it is expected that having more people come through the door will result in more people electing to purchase memberships at higher levels and making other purchases in the museum.

The Chair thanked Dr. Anderson for briefing the committee and for the DMA's efforts in the community.

This briefing provided the committee with information on Mango Complete 2.0 (Mango Languages Library Edition). The Council approved the contract for this online language learning service in December 2012, and it went online for use by Dallas residents in January 2013. Mango gives any Dallas resident with a library card the opportunity to learn more than 40 languages, and 15 English as a second language (ESL) courses taught in the patron's native language. Library patrons can login to the service from any computer in the world with internet access or through an app for smartphones and tablets.

Committee members expressed excitement for this new service. The Chair thanked Ms. Giudice for the presentation.
