BACKGROUND

- In September 1999, the Dallas Police Department and the Dallas County Constable for Precinct 3 partnered to address traffic and crime issues of mutual concern.
- In October 2000, the program was expanded to include the Dallas County Constable for Precinct 1.
- On December 17, 2002, the Constable Precincts were realigned and renumbered and the partnership was expanded to include all Precincts within the Dallas city limits.

BACKGROUND (cont.)

- The objectives of the partnership are to reduce traffic accidents and crime in Dallas by mutually addressing:
 - Traffic Enforcement
 - Truancy Enforcement
 - Warrant Service

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT

- The Police Department identifies and designates school zones, hazardous locations and multiple traffic accident locations.
- The Police Department shares intelligence information on these hazardous locations with the Constables' Offices.
- Each participating Constable's Office then commits deputies in marked vehicles for traffic enforcement.

TRUANCY ENFORCEMENT

- Communities with high rates of truancy are likely to have corresponding rates of daytime criminal activity and vandalism.
- Areas with truancy problems are identified.
- Under this cooperative agreement truants are apprehended by the Police Department and the Constable's Office and are returned to School Guidance Offices.

BENEFITS OF PROGRAM

- Traffic enforcement in hazardous/high accident areas has increased.
- Communication and cooperation between the agencies have improved.
- Constables have provided support personnel during special initiatives (truancy, prostitution, etc.).
- Positive impact on drop-out prevention

Cooperative Efforts

■ Southwest Division

- Precinct 1 & 5 work on joint operations in their areas conducting intensive directed patrols, securing scenes during critical incidents, crowd control situations and truancy initiatives.
- Precinct 1 assists Dallas Police at the Southwest Division in their target area and hot beats with traffic enforcement and increased police presence.
- Precinct 5 was instrumental in helping reduce crime throughout the Jefferson corridor neighborhood.

Cooperative Efforts

■ Northwest Division

- The Constables provide assistance with special initiatives such as truancy and traffic enforcement in west Dallas.
- The Dallas County Constables also assist the Northwest Division with crowd control situations at entertainment venues for special events.
- Assisted with the immigration reform march in downtown Dallas.
- 2nd watch meets weekly with pct. 5 to review the latest intelligence information.

Cooperative Efforts

■ Northeast Division

- Sergeants from Precinct 3 work closely with Northeast officers and attend the detail with ICP officers and share intelligence information.
- Precinct 3 has 1 Sergeant, 4 traffic officers, and 1 transport car that work at the Northeast Division.
- They work citizen complaints, traffic enforcement, and provide cover for officers on calls for service.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Continue the existing partnerships between the Police Department and the Dallas County Constables' Offices located within the city limits.
- Place resolution for continuation of the program on Council Agenda.
 - Precincts 1, 3, 4, and 5 are included in the partnership.
 - *Precinct 2 lies outside the city limits of Dallas.
