SUBJECT Trinity River Corridor Project  
Beckley Ave. at Commerce Street Intersection Improvement – PB980000 Supplemental Agreement #1 to contract with Bridgefarmer & Associates

The Trinity River Corridor Project Office currently has a contract with the consulting firm of Bridgefarmer & Associates to design the intersection improvement at Beckley Ave. and Commerce St. (see attachment A). Staff from Dallas Water Utilities has identified water and wastewater lines that need to be replaced or upsized in this area, and should be done in conjunction with the street / intersection reconstruction. Dallas Water Utilities is requesting that the consultant provide the design for the water and wastewater lines, through a supplemental agreement to their existing contract with the Trinity River Corridor Project Office. In addition, we are asking the consultant to provide survey control sheets that are necessary for final design. By having the consultant provide survey control sheets (as opposed to using City staff), we can expedite the project, and allow our City staff surveyors to continue with the critical path survey work they are doing for other parts of the Trinity River Corridor Project.

This item will be on the City Council agenda for approval on May 14, 2008, to increase the amount of the previous agreement by \$71,422, from \$203,700 to \$275,122. The funding for this supplemental agreement will come from Dallas Water Utilities funds (\$56,322) and Trinity River Corridor Project Bond funds (\$15,100).
