SUBJECT **Possible Inclusion on May 13, 2009 Council Agenda - Dallas Floodway Extension Property Acquisitions**

On May 13, 2009 Dallas City Council Agenda, The Trinity River Corridor Project Office will be requesting action to authorize the following Dallas Floodway Extension Property Acquisitions:

- Authorize acquisition, including the exercise of the right of eminent domain, if such becomes necessary, of five (5) unimproved tracts of land containing approximately 50 acres located near the intersection of Cedar Crest Boulevard and Pontiac Avenue for the Dallas Floodway Extension. (Not to exceed \$169,000)
- Authorize acquisition, including the exercise of the right of eminent domain, if such becomes necessary, of an unimproved tract of land containing approximately 54 acres located near the intersection of Morrell Avenue and Sargent Road for the Dallas Floodway Extension. (Not to exceed \$153,000)
