In 2009, the Trinity River Corridor Project launched a new program, the Trinity River Photo Contest. The program was widely embraced as 350 photographs were submitted for the contest. In October, a professional panel of judges selected the winning photographs and in November, an award ceremony was conducted at a City Council Briefing presenting the 49 winners with their prize money and certificates of participation.

The next phase of this program is to take the winning photographs on exhibit throughout Dallas. The exhibit locations include: Methodist Dallas Medical Center, African American Museum, Trinity River Audubon Center, Scottish Rite Hospital, and Janette Kennedy Gallery (formerly South Side Gallery).

The exhibit opening is on April 29, 2010 at Methodist Dallas Medical Center. There will be a reception sponsored by the hospital and you are cordially invited to attend this special presentation of the winning photographs depicting a different view of the Trinity Corridor as seen through the lens of photographers as young as 10 years old. The reception is from 6:00 p.m. - 7:30 p.m., Methodist Dallas Medical Center, 1444 North Beckley Avenue, Dallas, TX 75203 and it will be held in the main lobby. Indoor or outdoor parking is available at the normal parking rates and there is an underground garage immediately off the circle drive entry of the hospital.
