3. Administrative (Fire) Reports (Informational Memo)

4. Tour of Dallas Fire-Rescue Training Division Facility

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

At 11:03 a.m., the Public Safety Committee departed for a Tour of Dallas Fire-Rescue Training Division Facility located at 5000 Dolphin Road, Dallas, Texas 75223. Assistant Chief Salazar provided the committee with a Training Division Overview. The mission of the Division is to provide excellent training and education workforce programs covering: fire suppression, medical treatment, career development, and leadership to create the best customer service during emergency and non-emergency responses. Highlights of the presentation were as follows: (1) Mission Statement (2) New Recruit Training (3) New Recruit EMS Training (4) In-Service Training and (5) Professional Development.

DFR Training officers continually strive to enhance training through membership and participation in local and national training associations such as Fire Instructors Association of North Texas (FIANT).
