3. Crime Report

Presenter(s): Police Chief David M. Kunkle, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Chief Kunkle provided the committee with a discussion of the crime briefing. One of the key focus areas is public safety and one of the most important goals is to reduce crime. The following is a summary of the current crime report: (1) crime numbers continue to trend downward (2) 2007 had the best per capita crime numbers (3) homicides are down 19% and (5) the largest decrease is business burglaries.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) business burglaries (2) backlog of applicants and (3) recruit bonus.

4. Crisis Intervention Mental Health Officer Program

Presenter(s): Senior Corporal Herbert Cotner, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Senior Corporal Cotner provided the committee with a discussion of the Crisis Intervention Mental Health Officer Program. The mission of the program is as follows: (1) continue to strengthen the collaboration between police and mental health providers (2) enhance public safety (3) enhance officer safety through education and specialized training and (4) update department policies and procedures.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) crisis calls (2) 911 communication call takers trained to identify mental illness calls (3) mental illness awareness (4) mandatory 40 hour training course (5) DPD's role in mental illness out in the community (6) number of officers completed program and (7) community education.

Follow up: The chair requested that staff provide the committee with a memo explaining, if a 911 call is not coded as a mental illness call, is it possible to decode afterwards.
