

  - Fire Station 39 – 2850 Ruidosa (Council District 9)
  
- 2003 Bond Program
  - Fire Station 33 – 745 W. Illinois (Council District 3)
  - Fire Station 35 – 3839 Walnut Hill Lane (Council District 13)
  - Fire Station 38 – 2839 Wilhurt (Council District 4)
  - Fire Station 40\* – 2440 Kirnwood (Council District 8)
  - Fire Station 42 – 3333 W. Mockingbird (Council District 14)

# 2006 Bond Program

- Replacement Fire Station #6 (built 1954)
  - Current location – 2808 S. Harwood (Council District 7)
  - Funding approved - 7.6 million dollars
  - Estimated completion date – early 2012
  - Project currently in land acquisition phase



# 2006 Bond Program

- Remodeled Fire Station #10 (Originally built 1984)
  - Current location – 4451 Frankford Rd. (Council District 12)
  - Funding approved – 4.3 million dollars
  - Project completed – opened February 2010
  - Complete renovation of existing facility



# 2006 Bond Program

- Replacement Fire Station #27 (built 1948)
  - ❑ Current location – 8401 Douglas Avenue (Council District 13)
  - ❑ Funding approved – 8.3 million dollars
  - ❑ Estimated completion date – early 2012



# 2006 Bond Program

- Replacement Fire Station #32 (built 1951)
  - Current location – 7007 Benning Avenue (Council District 4)
  - Funding approved – 5.5 million dollars
  - Estimated completion date – early 2012
  - Project currently in land acquisition phase





# 2006 Bond Program

- Replacement Fire Station #37 (built 1954)
  - Current location – 6742 Greenville Avenue (Council District 9)
  - Funding approved – 7.6 million dollars
  - Estimated completion date – early 2012
  - Project currently in land acquisition phase



# 2006 Bond Program

- Replacement Fire Station #44 (built 1959)
  - Current location – 4114 Frank Street (Council District 7)
  - Funding approved – 5.5 million dollars
  - Estimated completion date – late 2011
  - Project currently in land acquisition phase



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# 2006 Bond Program

- New Fire Station #50
  - Location – Keeneland Pkwy/Walton Walker (Council District 3)
  - Funding approved – 6.7 million dollars
  - Estimated completion date – late 2011
  - Project currently in early design phase

- Future Site Acquisitions
  - 6700 West Kiest Blvd.
  - 4300 Mountain Creek Parkway
- Major Maintenance Projects
