3. Dangers in School Bus Crossing Zones (Informational)

Presenter: Dr. Rick Sorrells, Superintendent and Larry Duncan, Board President, DCS Ashley Wilson, Attorney, DCS

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Dr. Rick Sorrells, Superintendent and Larry Duncan, Board President with Dallas County Schools provided the committee with an overview to the Dangers in School Bus Crossing Zones. Dallas County Schools is the original school district in Dallas County and provides educational services such as media, psychological services, technology and transportation services to the school districts in Dallas County and around the state of Texas. DCS is the 5th largest provider of student pupil transportation in the United States with a fleet of over 1700 school buses transporting over 70,000 daily riders.

Topics of discussion were as follows: (1) plan of action (2) school crossing zone ordinance (3) system for monitoring school buses (4) enforcement (5) statistics (6) incidents (7) school bus danger zones (8) real time equipment (9) cameras (10) trained live personnel monitor all live feeds and (11) crossing zone violation enforcement protocol.

4. Crime Report

Presenter: Police Chief David Brown, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Chief Brown provided the committee with a progress report of the Police Department in crime. Crime Index is currently down 3.45%. Murders are down 17%, business robberies are down 28%, auto theft is down 8.28% and property crime is 87% of total crime.
