3. **Crime Report**

**Presenter:** Chief of Police David Brown, Dallas Police Department

**Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):**

Chief Brown provided the committee with a progress report of the Police Department in crime. Overall crime has decreased 7.6%. Auto theft has decreased 17%.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) public education (2) Operation Heat Wave (3) residential burglaries (4) hot spots (5) juvenile curfew (6) community engagement in the parks (7) track changes in crime categories (8) VIP, Crime Watch and ENP statistics (9) Weed and Seed initiative (10) reducing crime by intervention (11) Crime Watch and Neighborhood Association education (12) assessment for high crime areas (13) resources (14) statistics associated with neighborhoods (15) inventory personal property (16) UV pen to mark property and (17) graffiti abatement.

4. **Collaborative Youth Initiative Developing the Model**

**Presenter:** Assistant Chief Vincent Golbeck, Dallas Police Department

**Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):**

Assistant Chief Golbeck provided the committee with the Collaborative Youth Initiative Developing the Model presentation.

One of Dallas Police Department's most effective strategies in reducing crime will be to facilitate a multitude of partners and community assets to collaboratively break the cycle of crime in 7% of the City that represents 30% of total crime.

Goal of this collaboration is to transform youth's lives, thus transforming the community as a whole by building an innovative crime model (the Build Model) to accomplish this goal.

5. **Operation Heat Wave Summer Crime Initiative 2011**

**Presenter:** Deputy Chief Brigitte Gassaway, Dallas Police Department

**Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):**

Deputy Chief Gassaway provided the committee with the Operation Heat Wave Summer Crime Initiative 2011. The goal of the program is to reduce overall crime in the City of Dallas by focusing on property crimes, such as residential burglaries, business burglaries, burglaries of motor vehicle and thefts. Engage the Community in the Dallas Police Department crime reduction efforts. This initiative will be conducted from April 18, 2011 through August 31, 2011.

The Crime Analysis unit reviewed city crime trends and conducted comprehensive analysis to identify Targeted Area Action Grids (TAAG) for this operation. At least one TAAG area per Patrol Division was identified. The following is a list of crime prevention information that will be provided:

- Operation ID
- iWatch
- Lock/Take/Hide
- Crime Watch Opportunities
