3. Certificates for Demolition or Removal in Historic Districts

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Ms. O'Donnell provided the committee with the proposed changes to Article 51A-4.501 of the Dallas Development Code related to Certificates of Demolition or Removal of buildings in historic districts. Topics of discussion were as follows: (1) findings & purpose (2) certificate of demolition (3) threat to Public Health or Safety (4) current process and (5) proposed change to the standard for approval.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) expedite process (2) consent docket (3) number of properties scheduled to be demolished (4) Land Mark Commission involvement (5) community involvement (6) process to locate homeowner and (7) timeline to change policy.

<u>Follow up:</u> The chair requested that the Certificates for Demolition or Removal in Historic Districts briefing return to the Public Safety Committee Meeting for additional discussion regarding expediting the process.

4. Citizens Fire Academy

Presenter(s): Deputy Chief Daniel Salazar, Dallas Fire-Rescue Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Deputy Chief Salazar Kunkle provided the committee with an update to the Citizens Fire Academy. Highlights of the presentation were as follows: (1) mission (2) objective (3) benefits (4) customer service focus (5) training topics and (6) public relations and enrollment.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) criteria to participate in program (2) cost (3) number of citizens in program (4) pamphlets provided at town hall meetings with Police and Fire programs and (5) volunteer opportunities for graduates.

5. Wellness-Fitness Program

Presenter(s): Section Chief Norman Seals, Dallas Fire-Rescue Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Section Chief Seals provided the committee with the Wellness-Fitness Program. The importance of the program is as follows: (1) to protect DFR's #1 asset: Firefighters (2) improve the physical fitness of Firefighters and (3) identify and treat the medical hazards of the profession. On October 1, 2007 DFR received funding from the City Council for the Wellness-Fitness Program. Highlights of the presentation were as follows: (1) MedProvider (2) physical exams (3) fitness assessment (4) success stories (5) aggregate data (6) firefighters at high risk (7) peer fitness trainers and (8) future 2009-2010 program cycle.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) City of Dallas insurance plan (2) resistance from firefighters (3) timeline that all firefighters will be completed with program (4) confidentiality and (5) limit of liability.

<u>Follow up:</u> The chair requested that the Wellness-Fitness Program briefing return to the Public Safety Committee Meeting for an update in 6 months.
