A motion was made by Ms. Jasso to accept the upcoming council agenda items and recommend them to the full Dallas City Council for approval on the September 22, 2010 agenda. Mr. Kadane seconded the motion and it passed by unanimous vote.

4. Crime Report

Presenter: Chief of Police David Brown, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Chief Brown provided the committee with a progress report of the Police Department in crime. Crime Index is currently down 8.2%. Summer Crime Initiative Operation Triangle ended and yielded a 5% reduction in violent crime and a 5% reduction in property crime. Sexual assault reduced by 9%.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) hot spots (2) gang summit (3) repeat offenders (4) foot patrol (5) community policing and (6) cameras.

5. <u>Dallas Police Department Pursuit Overview</u>

Presenter: Deputy Chief Randall Blankenbaker, Dallas Police Department Deputy Chief Jesse Reyes, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Deputy Chief Blankenbaker provided the committee with the Dallas Police Department Pursuit Overview. A pursuit is defined as an active attempt by an officer in an authorized emergency vehicle to apprehend a fleeing suspect in a motor vehicle who is attempting to elude the officer. A suspect is considered to be fleeing upon making any overt action intended to avoid arrest. Deputy Chief Reyes provided the committee with step-by-step information to the Love Field Pursuit, August 19, 2010. Further Considerations are as follows: (1) DPD Command Staff and Senior Staff members of the Aviation Department are developing a stronger, more efficient communication protocol for developing incidents near the Love Field area (2) DPD studying the implementation of a practice to be followed when significant incidents develop near a critical location (3) Pursuit fell within DPD guidelines and (4) Pursuit concluded with no injury and minimal property damage.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) damage to streets (2) FAA/Homeland Security (3) pursuit initiation criteria (4) success of current policy (5) critical infrastructure (6) list of critical locations (7) road blocks (8) notification protocol (9) dash camera views and (10) statistics.

6. Homicide Report

Presenter: Deputy Chief Craig Miller, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Deputy Chief Miller provided the committee with an update to the Homicide Report. demographic information about homicides are as follows: (1) most violent days are Friday and Saturday night (2) most violent times of the day are 12:00 a.m. -6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to midnight (3) age of victim/suspect is 25-34 years old, followed by the 18-24 age group (4) motive for cases are altercations at 40% (5) handguns are the weapon used at 70% (6) type of premise murders occur are residence at 29%, followed by apartment's at 14% and (7) 57% of murders are in public places.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) update to Rockwall Lake incident (2) unknown motive (3) race of suspect and (4) unknown race of victim.

7. Crime Watch Organizations

Presenter: Assistant Chief Vincent Golbeck, Dallas Police Department

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Assistant Chief Golbeck provided the committee with an overview to the Crime Watch Organizations. The focus is hot spot policing and community engagement. The objectives are as follows: (1) identify those areas that are in need of community organization (2) improve communications between community groups and the police department, especially in the are of intelligence sharing (3) using social/media outlets to get information to and from the community faster and (4) work with police department's Office of Community Affairs to increase the 10/70/20 program.
