3. **Dallas Leadership Role in the National Institute of Health (NIH) Resuscitation Outcome Consortium (ROC)**

Presenter: Dr. Paul E. Pepe, Medical Director, Emergency Medical Services

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Dr. Pepe provided the committee with the Dallas Leadership Role in the National Institute of Health (NIH) Resuscitation Outcome Consortium (ROC) presentation.

In 2004 the U.S. NIH sent out an RFA to establish a network of 10 cities in North America that would drive national priorities in terms of uncovering new ways to save more lives following sudden cardiac arrest and trauma.

The Dallas area BioTel System (including Dallas & other member cities) was 1 of only 7 major U.S. municipal sites chosen.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) model city (2) metronome (3) public education (4) traditional CPR vs. minimally interrupted cardiac resuscitation (5) ALPS study (6) funding (7) concussion awareness and (8) plans for new CPR training class.
