TO: Members of the Public Safety Committee

SUBJECT: **Administrative (Fire) Reports**

This is an informational memo to provide the Public Safety Committee with a brief description of the August 13, 2013 – September 29, 2013 fire reports on Monday, October 14, 2013.

During this period, the following significant fires occurred:

During this reporting period, there were 2 (two) civilian fatalities. There were 2 (two) firefighter injuries, and 4 (four) civilian injuries that occurred as a result of structure fires. Also, there were 3 (three) civilian injuries that occurred as a result of two medical emergencies, for a grand total of 7 (seven) civilian injuries.

The fire completely destroyed the contents stored in the garage including two luxury automobiles and expensive photography equipment. A civilian injury occurred as a result of this incident. A 55-year old male sustained lacerations to his forearm and a finger attempting to extinguish the fire. He was transported to Doctors Hospital by Rescue 53. This detached garage did not have a properly installed fire alarm system. This is an insured loss. Engine 31 was the first unit to respond to this incident.</p>

There was no fire damage to this apartment. Two civilian injuries occurred as a result of this fire. A 29-year old female sustained second degree burns to her arms attempting to extinguish the fire. She tried to remove the ignited pan from the apartment. She was transported to Parkland hospital by Rescue 22. A 7-year old female sustained second degree burns to her face and extremities when her mother fell on her when she attempted to remove the ignited pan from the apartment. She was transported to Parkland Hospital by Rescue 48. This apartment had a properly installed fire alarm system. This system was not operational at the time of this incident.
