## 3. <u>Emergency Management and Homeland Security Overview</u>

#### Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Mr. Evans gave an overview of Emergency Management and Homeland Security. Mr. Shaw provided the committee with highlights of the Emergency Management program as follows: (1) purpose (2) history (3) four phases of emergency management (4) key programs and projects (5) CERT and (6) EOC activation. Mr. Vaz provided the committee with highlights of the Homeland Security Grants program as follows: (1) four grant programs (2) grant process (3) regional strategy (4) City of Dallas projects and (5) FY2009 funding and projects. Assistant Chief Campbell gave an overview to Dallas Fire-Rescue Homeland Security Bureau as follows: (1) purpose & direction (2) USAR (3) SwiftWater (4) Hazmat (5) Wildland and (6) ARFF – Aircraft Rescue Firefighting. Lt. Cotner provided the committee with an overview to the Dallas Police Department Homeland Security Operations as follows: (1) assessment of targeting/weapons (2) North Texas Joint Terrorism Task Force (3) DPD mobile command post (4) armored personnel carrier (5) love field police unit (6) fusion center and (7) response to the homeland security advisory system.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) level red (2) bomb squad (3) mobile medical unit (4) Tier I (5) plans for a catastrophe (6) strategy of funds to get allocated (7) public education and (8) mobile command post.

#### 4. Scofflaw Vehicle Registration Denial Program

#### Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Ms. Carter gave an overview of the Scofflaw Vehicle Registration Denial Program. Scofflaw is (1) one who habitually violates the law or fails to answer court summonses and (2) the owner of a vehicle who has an outstanding warrant from that municipality for failure to appear, or failure to pay a fine on a complaint that involves the violation of a traffic law. Topics of discussion were as follows: (1) purpose (2) timeline of Dallas County Program (3) implementation costs/revenue (4) process and (5) next steps.

The committee had the following concerns/recommendations: (1) unpaid traffic violations (2) provide citizens information on ways to pay their fine (3) Dallas County "Wanted" website (4) number of scofflaw cases (5) number of citations per year (6) cost for warrant roundups (7) costs/revenue (8) county & city partnership and (9) communications charges.
