Maintenance Deficiency Correction Period (MDCP) September and October 2009  
Update**

As of October 23, 2009, the City has completed 105 of the 198 items in the MDCP plan which is the action plan staff submitted to the US Corps of Engineers (USACE) to address the O&M deficiencies in the levee system as described in the Periodic Inspection Report No. 9. According to the USACE, the O&M repairs of unacceptable items must be completed by April 1, 2010, for the levee system to be eligible for rehabilitation assistance. The USACE approved this City's action plan on June 30, 2009.
