3. Modernization Of Dallas' Radio Network

Presenter: Worris Levine, Director, CIS

Charles Burki, Assistant Director, CIS Rocky Vaz, Executive Officer, IGS

Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):

Mr. Levine provided the committee with the Modernization of Dallas' Radio Network.
