SUBJECT Fuel Management System Upgrade - Addendum Item for December 14, 2011

The subject item will request Council approval for the purchase and installation of hardware and software to upgrade the existing fuel management system through the United States General Services Administration Schedule Contract. Equipment and Building Services uses the current fuel management system to manage eight fuel islands that collectively receive and dispense approximately 6.8 million gallons of fuel annually. This system is no longer supported by the manufacturer and has been replaced by AssetWorks FuelFocusTM fuel management system.

An upgrade of the system is necessary to obtain technical support and to continue implementation and enhancement of a number of internal processes and controls in our fuel operations. Some of the most significant benefits of the upgraded system include an improved and integrated process for managing bulk fuel orders from vendors, receipt of bulk fuel deliveries, transaction-specific fuel issuance at the fuel islands, and bulk transfers of fuel within our system of storage tanks. In addition, the new system will provide greater reporting capabilities facilitating more accountable, efficient and effective fuel operations overall. The software manufacturer, AssetWorks, is also the provider of the City's fleet management system, so there should be seamless integration of the two.
