BACKGROUND

The Dallas-Fort Worth Regional Airport Board, later renamed the Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport Board was created by contract and agreement between the City of Dallas and the City of Fort Worth. The City Council of the City of Dallas is authorized to appoint seven (7) members to the DALLAS/FORT WORTH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BOARD; Place Nos. 1, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10 and 11.

On November 15, 2006, Ms. Gates was appointed to the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Board for a term to expire July 1, 2007. Ms. Gates resigned as a member of the DFW Board on December 05, 2006. 

- --Not be an employee or a business associate of either an adversary party or a representative of an adversary party, nor have a pecuniary interest, in any pending litigation or claim, other than an eminent domain proceeding.
- -- Not be in arrears on any city taxes, water service charges or other obligations owed the city.
- -- Have a creditable record of attendance and performance in any previous board service.
