- Place 05 Ben Muro (Serving as "holdover")
- Place 11 Ricardo Medrano (Serving as "holdover")

- Place 01 Sanmi Akinmulero - co-nominated by Mayor Pro Tem Hill and Councilmember Thornton-Reese
- Place 05 Ben Muro - renominated by Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Garcia
- Place 11 John Loza - co-nominated Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Garcia, Councilmember Medrano and Councilmember Salazar.

BACKGROUND

The Dallas-Fort Worth Regional Airport Board, later renamed the Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport Board was created by contract and agreement between the City of Dallas and the City of Fort Worth. The City Council of the City of Dallas is authorized to appoint seven (7) members to the DALLAS/FORT WORTH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BOARD; Place Nos. 1, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10 and 11.

The current status of members on the DFW Board is shown below:

Place 01 Vacant **Term expires 1/31/2007**
Position previously held by Pamela Dunlop Gates, originally appointed February 28, 2001 for a term to expire January 31, 2003. She was reappointed February 19, 2003 for a term to expire January 31, 2005. She was reappointed May 11, 2005 for a term to expire January 31, 2007. On November 15, 2006, Ms. Gates was appointed to the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Board for a term to expire July 1, 2007. Ms. Gates resigned as a member of the DFW Board on December 05, 2006. An appointment to this position would expire January 31, 2009.

- Place 04 J. Jan Collmer W M 12 Term expires 01/31/2008
Mr. Collmer was first appointed November 10, 2004 for a term to expire January 31, 2006. He was reappointed February 8, 2006 for a term to expire January 31, 2008.
- Place 05 **Ben Muro** H M 11 Term expires 01/31/2007
Mr. Muro was first appointed April 20, 2005 for a term that expired January 31, 2007. Mr. Muro is currently serving as a "holdover". An appointment or reappointment to this position would expire January 31, 2009.
- Place 06 Robert Hsueh A M 11 Term expires 01/31/2008
Mr. Hsueh was appointed to fill the unexpired term of Max Wells on May 11, 2005 effective July 19, 2005 for a term to expire January 31, 2006. He was reappointed February 8, 2006 for a term to expire January 31, 2008.
- Place 09 Michael Sorrells B M 03 Term expires 1/31/2008
Mr. Sorrells was first appointed February 8, 2006 for a term to expire January 31, 2008.
- Place 11 **Ricardo Medrano** H M 02 Term expires 1/31/2007
Mr. Medrano was first appointed January 5, 2000 for a term to expire January 31, 2001. He was reappointed on February 28, 2001 for a term to expire January 31, 2003. He was reappointed February 19, 2003 for a term to expire January 31, 2005. He was reappointed again April 20, 2005 for a term to expire January 31, 2007. He is currently serving as a "Holdover" in his fourth and final term. An appointment to this position would expire January 31, 2009.
